The Canterbury Police Department will begin a new service entitled "**Are You OK**" Program.

This service is designed to check the safety and welfare of elderly or disabled individuals within our community who live alone or have special needs. When a person decides to enroll in this program, the person will sign a contract agreeing to phone the police department each day, **Monday Through Friday**, between the hours of **9:00 AM and 11:00 AM**. The person will just need to identify him or herself and state that they are checking in as part of the Are You OK program.

If the police department has not heard from a person enrolled in this program by 11:00 AM, contact will be attempted by telephone. If there is no answer, a police officer will be dispatched to the residence to check the safety and welfare of the person. Persons enrolled in the program will be required to supply the police department with a key to his or her residence. The key will be maintained in a secure location at the police department.

A copy of the enrollment form is attached to this cover letter. You will be required to contact the police department to make arrangements to complete this form in the presence of an officer or other staff member.

I am a resident of the Town of Canterbury and I am interested in enrolling into the "Are You OK" Program. I understand that this program will run **Monday through Friday** of each week between the hours of **9:00 AM and 11:00 AM**. I understand that I will be required to call the POLICE DEPARTMENT during the times listed above Monday through Friday at **783-0433**. This service WILL NOT be provided during weekend and holidays.

I understand that if I do not call the police department during the days and time frame listed above that member of the police department will be calling me at 11:00AM to check on my safety and welfare. I further understand that if no response is received by telephone, that an officer will be dispatched to my residence to check my welfare. I understand that I must provide a key to my residence as part of this program and that the officer will gain entry to my home by using this key. The police department has informed me that the key to my residence will be securely kept at the police department and will only be used in an emergency.
